



UPDATES TO THE DKSO PLAN OF ACTION November 17, 2020

Due to increases in the number of positive tests for COVID-19 Coronavirus among inmates, a Phase Two quarantine period will be implemented beginning on November 18, 2020. This action is taken in compliance with recommendations of WellPath, our inmate health services provider. The quarantine will be in effect for 14 days.

The current level of restriction on access to the facility will remain with these exceptions.

- On-site visits are limited to inmate attorneys.
- Outside agency requests for visits will be evaluated individually.
- On-site recruitment and hiring processes will be adjusted to accommodate individuals interested in joining our team.

We will continue to emphasize the importance of sanitizing the premises, including conducting in-service training for staff on the proper use of PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) and use of sanitizers at frequently-used stations such as KeyTrac.

- Inmate housing unit cleaning and sanitizing will continue but at an increased rate.
- The employee mandate for facial masks remains in effect.

We are aware of the potential impact of an additional quarantine period on those in our custody, and our Mental Health services providers are active team members with WellPath to assist inmates and to ensure that this initiative has a positive outcome.
